### K-WINGS STALL IN SECOND, DROP FIRST GAME IN WORCESTER

The Kalamazoo Wings (21-17-0-0) couldn't respond to the Worcester Railers' (16-18-1-1) strong second period and lost by a score of 5-2 at the DCU Center Friday. Twelve seconds is all it took for the Railers to take control of this one, as Worcester marched down the ice at the start of the second and broke the 1-1 tie. The goal came on a pretty simple zone entry off the center ice draw that found the stick of Railers forward Reece Newkirk (7), and he was able to find rookie Jacob Hayhurst (7) on the doorstep for the score. Kalamazoo was able to sustain pressure for the remainder of the period with a couple good scoring opportunities, but Worcester added another tally at the 15:14 mark to push the score to 3-1. The K-Wings came out strong in the third, scoring just 16 seconds in and pulled to within one. Justin Murray's fourth of the season, from inside the blue line, assisted by Jeremy Masella (2), gave the team life to start the final frame. But the Railers capitalized again at the 3:02 mark, added the empty net goal and coasted to victory. Greg Betzold (7) did extend his point streak to five games (3G, 2A) with his first period goal via another nifty redirection off the Andrew DeBrincat (14) shot from the point. Cody Corbett (10), earned the second assist on the goal and extended his point streak to four games (4A). Trevor Gorsuch (10-10) made 38 saves in the loss.

### STAY THE COURSE

The K-Wings have been here before. Friday's are proving to be a tough test for Kalamazoo as it's 4-9 this season to start the weekend. But there are some positives. The K-Wings were able to work veteran Eric Kattelus into the line up and he looked very comfortable after his second shift. His presence was felt on the blue line and he even threw the body around a bit. Forward Greg Betzold (7G, 9A) extended his scoring streak to 5-games (3G, 2A) with his first period goal, and has the look of an offensive player ready to explode. Trevor Gorsuch (10-10) was also fantastic despite four goals against. Gorsuch (38 saves) stopped break-aways, 2-on-1's and controlled his rebounds admirably. The key to getting back into the win column for Kalamazoo is finding a way to hold the lead at the end of the first or second period. The K-Wings are 27-3-0-0 combined when exiting those two periods on-top.

### OFF THE RAILS

The Worcester Railers are not a team to overlook, and this is the first time the two franchises have met a season. Despite their Conference and Division standings, this is a team that's really starting to hit their stride. The Railers longest winning streak of the season (4G) was snapped last Sunday (FW, 6-4) and they've won 5 of their last 6 games. Over that span of 6-games, Worcester's netted 33 goals. Players to watch: Jordan Smotherman (17-15-32) & Anthony Repaci (13-16-19). Smotherman's 9-game point streak (7G, 6A) was snapped last night - but his leadership on the ice was apparent - as he was a constant offensive threat. Repaci extended his point streak to 6-games last night with a goal (5G, 5A) and has now notched a score in 4 straight.

### MARTIN TAKES RIGHTFUL PLACE IN HOF

K-Wings Assistant Coach Joel Martin was formally inducted into the 14th class of the ECHL Hall of Fame during the 2022 Warrior Hockey/ECHL All-Star Classic in Jacksonville on Jan. 17. The historic former netminder ranks second in league history with 22,962 minutes played, third with 394 appearances and fourth with 199 ECHL wins. Martin is also the only goaltender in league history to record three 30 victory seasons.

### K-WING MILESTONES

Tonight's Matheson Iacopelli's 100th ECHL game. Last night, Greg Betzold played his 200th ECHL game. Justin Taylor (207) also passed K-Wings legend Eric Kattelus (206) for sole possession of 7th all-time in assists in franchise history with his helper on Jan. 21 against Wheeling.

# KALAMAZOO WINGS BIOS



## **HEAD COACH: Nick Bootland (13th season)**

Bootland is in his 13th season as Head Coach and Director of Hockey Operations for Kalamazoo, having originally been named to the position on May 29, 2008. He has led the K-Wings to the division title in four of their 11 seasons in the ECHL and to eight appearances in the Kelly Cup Playoffs. The winningest coach in K-Wings history, Bootland has compiled a record of 445-330-81 during his tenure behind the K-Wings bench. Of those victories, 401 came in the ECHL and the rest during his first season, when the Wings were members of the IHL. Bootland signed a four-year extension with Kalamazoo entering the 2019-20 season. He is the longest-tenured coach in the ECHL and became just the 5th coach in league history to coach 800 games, doing so on Sunday, December 12, 2021 versus the Indy Fuel.

Prior to his coaching career, the native of Shelburne, Ontario spent ten seasons as a pro across the AHL, IHL, UHL, and ECHL. He spent his final three full seasons in Kalamazoo and wore the 'C' as the team's captain. During the 2006 season, Bootland helped lead the Kalamazoo Wings to their first championship in 25 years, as they lifted the Colonial Cup as champions of the UHL. He was a ninth round (220th overall) draft pick of the Dallas Stars in the 1996 NHL Entry Draft.

## **ASSISTANT COACH: Joel Martin (3rd season)**

Martin enters his third season behind the bench as Kalamazoo's Assistant Coach and Goaltending Coach. He ended a 15-year playing career following the 2017-18 season, his ninth with Kalamazoo. The all-time winningest goaltender in K-Wings history, Martin finished his career ranked fourth in ECHL history in wins, tied for sixth in regular season shutouts, and had the fifth best season by a goaltender in ECHL history, posting 36 victories in 2015-16. When he retired Martin ranked first in Kalamazoo Wings history in wins (229), shutouts (21), games played (422), minutes played (24,755), and saves (12,310). Martin was also a member of the 2005-06 Colonial Cup Championship team along with head coach Nick Bootland. Prior to making his professional debut in 2003 with the Bakersfield Condors, Martin spent three seasons in the Western Hockey League with Lethbridge, Tri-City, Vancouver, and Calgary.
